Last call on SX-based BASIC Stamp products

Parallax pioneered the 50 Million Instruction Per Second SX 8-bit microcontroller with Scenix Semiconductor (later Ubicom) in 1997. These 8-bit controllers were used in several designs at Parallax. The settlement of a patent infringement lawsuit brought against Ubicom in 2009 called for a mandatory End Of Life (EOL) agreement on the SX.

Parallax announced the EOL process for the SX28AC/SS-G microcontrollers in 2009. At that time we offered our customers a LifeTime Buy (LTB) for production purposes. Parallax held inventory reserves to guarantee our customers a multi-year supply of the SX-based BASIC Stamp products.

Today — seven years later — is the final EOL announcement for products made with the SX28AC/SS-G:
